

House Rules JCI World Congress 2017 Amsterdam

1. The Congress Organizing Committee (the “COC”) can ask delegates to show a valid ID at any time and the delegates need have to be in possession of a valid Congress badge.
2. The COC reserves the right to refuse / deny (further) access to delegates in a drunken state and/or under the influence of narcotics.
3. The possession or dealing of narcotics is prohibited at the Congress. If there is any evidence of overt use and/or possession, confiscation of the narcotics will follow and/or the offending delegate will be handed over to the police.
4. The COC and the (security) staff at the Congress (venues) are allowed to search delegates pre-emptively and check their (hand) bags to ensure the safety of all delegates. Possession of glass, cans, fireworks, narcotics, (fire) arms and/or other dangerous or prohibited items or substances and/or pets are not allowed.
5. The delegates of the Congress enter all Congress events and venues at their own risk. The COC nor the Congress takes no responsibility for any damages on any grounds whatsoever, which directly or indirectly arise out of acts or omissions of the COC, persons in its service, other persons who are working at the Congress, or third parties during or in connection with the Congress, unless the damage is caused by intent or gross negligence.
6. Smoking is not permitted in the tents nor in the Congress venues.
7. The COC will not tolerate threats, abuse, discrimination, sexual harassment and other nuisance, unacceptable and/or offensive behavior. This type of misbehavior will lead to removal from the Congress and/or the offending delegate will be handed over to the police.
8. It is not allowed to make professional audio or video recordings without written permission from the COC.
9. When entering and leaving the Congress venues the delegates must not cause nuisance to the neighborhood.
10. Glasses / cups, with or without content, are not allowed to be taken outside the venues of the Congress.
11. Delegates are held to follow instructions, regulations and/or directions of the COC and the (security) staff at all times.
12. Access to the venues of the Congress will be denied to delegates who do not comply with the house rules without the right to reimbursement of the Congress Fee and/or other costs.
13. The Congress has a zero tolerance policy for excessive drinking, use, possession and dealing of narcotics, sexual harassment, abuse, discrimination, racism and / or abuse/misuse of a Congress badge.

14. The COC reserves the right to take any and all (enforcement) measures against delegates in other (unforeseen) circumstances and / or offenses, for situations which are not explicitly described in our house rules.
15. The COC reserves the right to (i) cancel; (ii) move; or (iii) change parts of the Congress and/or under-subscribed excursions, without prior notice.
